### **Live Presentation → Recorded Videos**

In place of live presentations, each team will record a video to demonstrate their project. We want to be flexible to your circumstances and also encourage creativity. The only guidelines for these videos are:

- 1) The video should be 5-8 minutes long.
- 2) If only one team member is narrating the video, they should briefly mention how other team members contributed.
- 3) The video should be uploaded to YouTube and a link emailed to [studenthack@franklin.edu](mailto:studenthack@franklin.edu).

**Privacy:** Please set your video as "Unlisted" so it can only be accessed via the link you share.

**Intellectual Property:** Please do not use any copyrighted music, graphics, logos, etc., in your videos.

We will compile all the submitted video links into a YouTube Playlist and send it out to all judges, students, and teachers to view. Judges may ask questions via the comment section on your video. *You are not required to respond*, but it may be helpful to answer if further information is needed.

In addition to the Franklin & Urbana scholarships for every finishing team and the cash prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place, we have added *three sets of Hackers' Choice Awards* chosen by students voting on each other's videos. Every member of a Hacker's Choice winning team will be emailed a \$50 Amazon gift card. We will send out voting instructions later on.
